 the appurtenances belonging or apperteyning to them Item I give unto my said wiffe four and twenty of
 my best milke Ewe that I have going in or vpon my Demaine landes at Berpore Item I give my said
 wiffe all my swyne and pultrye and all the malke that shalbe at the tyme of my death in my dwelling
 house Berpore garnerd fill or yelding house at Berpore Item I give unto my said wiffe all the
 cheese and butter and all other virtually that shalbe in my house at the tyme of my death Item all my horses
 and mares that are appoynted for laboring horses for to mowe trowe to the mill and to drawe the Cart
 Item I doe give unto my said wiffe the occupation suchly of all my householde stuff and plate during her
 widowhood Saving that I doe give unto my some Drudde Bassett being my exors two fetherbedds
 with therir appurtenances And I doe give unto my some John Bassett one fetherbedd with his
 appurtenances And whensoever it shall happen my said wiffe to dye or to marrie Then I will that all
 the said householde stuff and plate shalbe equally divided betwixt my three some Richard Bassett
 Drudde Bassett and John Bassett or betwixt as many of them as then shalbe living Saving that
 my will is that all my standig bedsteds and waunstoff that shalbe in my house at Berpore at the
 tyme of my death shall remaine undivided after my wives death or marriage to my some Richard
 Bassett Item I doe give and bequeathe unto my daughter Marye Bassett two hundred pounes
 of Lawfull money of England to be payde unto her within one yeare next after my death Item I doe
 give and bequeathe unto Catherine Thomas eldest daughter unto Robert Thomas of Brigan fortye
 pounes of Lawfull money of England to be payde unto her within two yeares next after my death
 Item I doe give unto Elizabeth Thomas daughter unto the said Robert Thomas whoe is and hath
 bene broughte upp in my house this manye yeares nowe passed twenty pounes of lawfull money
 of England to be payde unto her within three yeares next after my death Item I doe give unto
 every of the said Robert Thomas his other daughters that he hath by my daughter being his wiffe
 and that shalbe and remaine unmarried at the tyme of my death some pounes of lawfull money of
 England to be payde unto them one yeare next after an other after that there twoe saide sisters
 marriage money be or oughte to be payde unto them And if any of the said Robert Thomas his saide
 Daughters doe happen to dye before marriage Then my will is that furthe marriage money as I have by
 this will given unto her or them that shall so happen to dye before marriage shalbe equally divided
 betwixt the rest of the sisters that shalbe then living and unmarried And provided allwayes that
 the said Robert Thomas shall not meddle or deale with any parte of his saide Daughters
 marriage money that I doe by this will give them But my will is that my said wiffe being there
 grandmother shall during her life take order for the receiving and the setting forth of her saide
 needed marriage money to certayne to thier uses till they be married Item I doe give and bequeathe
 unto my some Drudde Bassett being my exors my lease that I had of the late Abbot and Covent
 of Slarstere vpon the rectorye and tithing barne of Lantardan for the terme of fower score and one
 yeare whiche lease beareth date the Twelue daye of marche in the nyne and twentieth yeare of Kinge
 Henry the eighth To have and to holde the saide lease together with the saide Rectorye and tithing
 barne with all the tithing corne and tithing haye and all other tithing whatsoever unto the saide Rectorye
 and barne belongeth or appertyneth Saving that my will is that my saide exors and his assignes
 shall deliver unto my saide wiffe out of the saide barne or ell whiche twoe bushells of sufficient wheate
 of Cambridge measure every weeke during the terme of fower yeares the saide terme to begynne the first
 daye of September next after my death And my will is that my saide wiffe shall have all the saide
 wheate free without paying of any thing for it Item I doe give bequeathe assigne and appointe unto
 my saide some Drudde Bassett and his assignes all my leases that I and Richard William gentleman
 had of the late Abbot and Covent of Gloucestre And the Decane and Chapter of the Cathedral
 Church of Gloucestre aforesaid of and vpon the manors and Lordshippes with thier appurtenances
 whatsoever To have and to holde unto the saide Drudde Bassett and his assignes for and during all
 furthe termes of yeares as be in the saide lease unexpired and also one assignement whiche I had of
 the saide Richard William of a lease that he had vpon the saide manors and Lordshippes To have
 and to holde the saide leases and assignement together with the saide manors and Lordshippes with
 thier appurtenances whatsoever unto the saide Drudde Bassett and his assignes for and during

the said manors and Lordshippes

all such terms of yeares as be in the said lease unexpired. Item I will that the said Arnold Bassett being my executor and his assignes shall of the issues and profitte that shall be made yearly out of the said lordshippes of Dregoff and Demmon from time to time and all times exonerate discharge and save harmed Sir Wierick gentleman his heires executor and administrators from and returning all manner of actions suits quarrells and demands wherewith the said Sir Wierick his heires executor or administrators maye be unjustly molested or troubled for the manors of Boulston according to the covenantes agreed upon and specified in a parte of indentures of bargain and sale made betwixte the said Sir Wierick and me touching the said manors. Item I give unto my said executor and to his assignes all my other leases whiche I shall have at the time of my death within the County of Glamorgan aswell by wayroll as in writing. Item I give unto my said executor and to his assignes all my other goodes and rattlell whiche are not, nor shall not, be bequeathed by this will with all my Corne in the grounde and out of the grounde, and all such debtes as is or shall be owing unto me at the time of my death. All whiche goodes rattlell Corne and debtes with all the issues and profitte of all such farms and leases as I doe give and leave unto my said executor shall be payable to and for the payment of all my debtes and legacies. Item I doe give unto my said sonne the said Arnold Bassett the Rowson of Penmachre Lanford and Cardiff. Item I doe give unto my daughter Elizabeth some poundes of lawfull money of England to be paid unto her within one yeare next after my death. And vice versa of this my last will and testament I doe ordayne and appointe my wife and my sonne Richard Bassett. And I doe will that my said executor and his assignes shall yearly within ffifteen dayes next after Michaelmas daye make a true Arroumpte unto my said overseers what he hath made of the issues and profitte of all the leases and farms as I doe leave him and of the Corne that shall growe in or upon them and of all such other stock as shall be upon them And of all such other goodes rattlell and rone in the grounde and out of the grounde as I doe or shall leave unto my said executor at the time of my death towards the payment of my debtes and legacies. And I doe by this will give unto my said overseers full power and authoritie for to compele my said executor and his assignes yearly for to make the said Arroumpte before them or any of them that shall then be living untill my said executor and his assignes have made full Arroumpte of all such somes of money as shall paye my wholle debtes and legacies and also paye the same. And after that the said debtes shall be fully paid that from thenceforth no more Arroumptes shall be required by my said overseers of my said executor nor of his assignes. And I doe give unto my said sonne Richard Bassett for his partes my best pyced gyltinge. In witness that this is my last will and testament I have written it with mine owne hande and putt my seale and subscribed my name unto it. William Bassett. Memorand that wee whose names underwritten have seene this will sealed at the testato handes and are witnesses thereunto Thomas Williams Clerk and John Roberts.

And in the end to receive me into his heavenly Kingdome wherof I have full assurance suchly throughte Christ my savyour and not by any other deservt whatsoever. And as for this fleshye bodye of myne I comitt it to the earth at the discretion of my executor. And as touching all my worldly goodes whiche god hath here lent me I will that they shall remaine as followeth. First I will to the poore of Chartham ffive poundes. And to the poore of Ellam other
